## PANI Impact Soars: 30K+ Lives Reached

Monsoons have replenished ponds restored under our flagship PANI initiative, with villages in Jharkhand, Haryana, Bihar, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Jharkhand and Telangana witnessing full water bodies, improved irrigation facilities, and higher hope for a fertile year. Over **30,100** people are now directly benefiting from revived water sources—proof that when communities care, nature responds.



## Empowering Futures Through STEM

OneStager Sujeet Kumar visited BVN School, Bangaluru to review the STEM Innovation Lab project, supported by GlobalLogic. The well-equipped lab engages **939** students in hands-on STEM learning. During his visit, Sujeet joined an orientation session with school authorities, reinforcing shared goals for STEM-led futures and improved student outcomes.



## Strengthening Forest-Based Livelihoods in Chhattisgarh

A planning & review meeting in Bhandardipa, Samri (Chhattisgarh) brought together forest dwellers, farmers, and panchayat members under the Hindalco supported Mahua harvesting and processing project implemented by OneStage. Key outcomes included a canopy distribution drive for **1,000** mahua trees, with focus on sustainable harvesting, enhancing income generation by linking local producers to wider markets and encouraging value addition through grading and packaging.

## Plastic Mukt Gurugram Begins with Young Changemakers

The Plastic Mukt Gurugram campaign kicked off with students at Government Schools of Gurugram district. Awareness sessions and engaging activities encouraged children to become champions of a plastic-free future. By starting with the youth, OneStage is planting seeds of sustainable behavior that will shape Gurugram's journey toward zero single-use plastic.



## Rebuilding Education in Koimari, Barpeta

OnStage Lead-Programs Sujit Sahu visited Koimari L.P. School in Assam's Barpeta district, where a 1,416 sq. ft. flood-resilient Green School is under construction to support the education of **170** children currently studying in makeshift spaces. The project—supported by Group Legrand India and implemented by OneStage with Citizens Foundation—will feature BaLA and digital classrooms. Despite logistical hurdles, including a mile-long walk through fields, this initiative brings hope for safe, climate-resilient learning.



## Due Diligence at Scale: Collaborative Philanthropy Foundation Update

OneStage in partnership with CPF continues to strengthen India's Not for Profit sector. In July 2025, the Collaborative Philanthropy Foundation has completed **5** due diligence and compliance checks—ensuring donor confidence and verifying credible NGOs. **11** RFPs were floated in July, totaling **20** RFPs circulated in FY 2025-26 to **32** validated NGOs driving transparency, credibility, and informed philanthropy.
