

#### Plastic Mukt Gurugram: Young Minds, **Big Change**

OneStage, under the #PlasticMuktGurugram campaign, conducted interactive awareness sessions across schools and slum communities in Gurugram. Through group discussions, real-life stories, and hands-on activities, over 2,000+ children were sensitized about the harmful effects of single-use plastics. By turning young minds into eco-champions, the campaign sparked a ripple of change towards a cleaner, healthier, plastic-free Gurugram.

#### **Breaking Barriers in School Health**

With support from The Jansen Foundation, OneStage launched the School Transformation Program in Ajmer, Rajasthan. In its first month, the initiative reached 650 students across 5 schools, driving open conversations on menstrual health and strengthening WASH practices.



### **Dokra Artisans of Kondagaon: Heritage Meets Opportunity**

OneStage, with support from Pernod Ricard India Foundation, engaged with 40 artisans, trainers, and local leaders in Karanpur, Kondagaon, Chhattisgarh. Together, we launched a community-driven initiative to preserve heritage, tackle marketing challenges, and build sustainable livelihoods for 250 artisans.
