### Legrand Team Visit Reinforces Climate-Resilient School Rebuilding

The project restores safe, climate-resilient education for over **200** children in an underserved region.

## Empowering Dhokra Artisans Through Design and Marketing

OneStage, supported by Pernod Ricard India Foundation through the Weaving Dreams Project, has strengthened Kondagaon and Bastar Dhokra artisans' skills. Over six intensive training batches, **250** artisans received design innovation and marketing support, enhancing product quality, market access, and sustainable livelihoods. This initiative bridges skill gaps while securing a resilient future for craft communities.



## Transforming Schools for Inclusive Learning Environments
